Sunday, October 18 - Twentieth Sunday after Pentecost; Online and 11:00 am Courtyard Worship

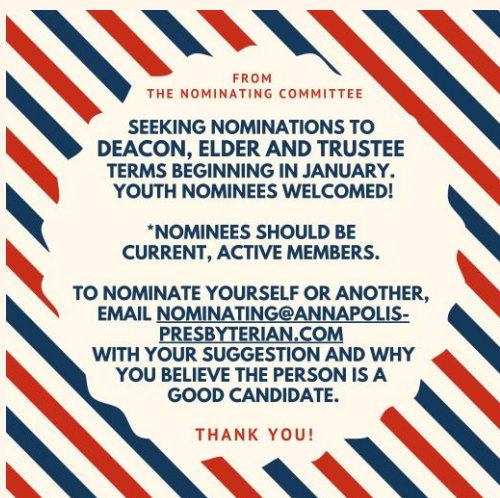
