**Fields:**

All fields are at Annapolis Middle School, Forest Dr. and Spa Rd. Fields are numbered clockwise, starting with field closest to intersection of Forest and Spa.

**RULES:**

- 1. ARRIVE BY 6:15, START TIME 6:30, FORFEIT TIME 6:45**
- In base running, tie goes to the fielder
- Each batter starts with one strike and one ball. All fouls are strikes. Four balls is a walk.
- Minimum arc on pitches is 6' above ground. 5. Maximum arc is 12' above ground
- Minimum age to play is 14
- Minimum # of players is 8, including catcher.  
For the 10 fielding positions, the maximum # of males is 8.
- If a team has no women, the first and fifth slots in the batting order are automatic outs. If a team has one women, the first slot in the batting order is an automatic out. These rules apply each time these slots would bat.
- No sliding, running into fielders or fielders diving to second and third base to make a play. To help avoid injuries, there shall be two first base bags and two home plates (One for the runner and one for the fielder). A runner trying to score will be out if the fielder touches the fielder's home plate before the runner touches the runner's home plate. The distance between bases should be 60 feet.
- If, at the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> inning, a team is ahead of the opposing team by 10 runs or more, the game is over.
- If any disagreement occurs regarding judgment calls, both managers need to confer as soon as possible, discuss the call, and take appropriate actions to resolve the disagreement. If the managers conclude that each has a different viewpoint, the call should be resolved by a coin flip.
